Volatile Relations is developed from Knezevic's 2023 text work, *I am* young so *I don't think about my death (that much)*. Borrowing the already confessional narrative, the work is further personalised through spoken word. Diaristic but unmonumental clips from everyday life play picture in picture with pop culture references, from *Spider-Man* to *True Blood*. The artist recalls childhood memories as fragmented anecdotes in an attempt to come to terms with mortality. Despite the heaviness, the work is instantaneously and unequivocally a love letter to parents and life itself.
